

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE

**Elk Rapids Township, Antrim County
Resolution #2016-8**

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Elk Rapids Township wishes to provide funds for continued improvement, repair, paving and maintenance of established roads located within the Township; and

WHEREAS, Townships may provide funds for continued improvement, repair, paving and maintenance of established roads located within the Township; and

WHEREAS, Townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Elk Rapids Township wishes to levy .35 mills to provide funds for continued improvement, repair, paving and maintenance of established roads located within the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Elk Raids Township, Antrim County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 2, 2016 election ballot:

Shall the expired previous voted increases in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Elk Rapids Township, of .35 mills (\$.35 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value), reduced to .3471 mills (\$.3471 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted .35 mills (\$.35 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) and levied for six (6) years, 2016 through 2021 inclusive, to provide funds for continued improvements, repair, paving and maintenance of established roads located within the Township, raising an estimated \$85,767.25 in the first year the millage is levied?
